Traveling by car is our recommended way as it is the great way to see Thailand because you can do sightseeing and stop by anywhere you want. From Bangkok, motorists can travel through Highway 1 up north to Wang Noi of Ayutthaya, then use Highway 32, through Ang Thong, Sing Buri, Chai Nat, and Nakhon Sawan. It is about a 237 kilometres drive and takes about 2 hours. Then, get on Highway 117 bound for Phitsanulok. This route is 140 kilometres long and takes about 1.30 hours. So this route, which is the most convenient way, is 377 kilometres long all together and it takes about 3.30 - 4 hours.
